What is PBSIS?

PBSIS stands for Positive Behavior Support in Schools. It is a program designed to create a positive, safe, and respectful learning environment for all students. At Lindeneau, we emphasize the values of being **Respectful, Responsible, and Safe**. Our goal is to reinforce these behaviors to build a strong school community.

How Do Tiger Tickets Work?

Tiger Tickets are our way of saying "thank you" to students for making good behavior choices. These tickets are an important part of our PBSIS program and encourage students to continue making positive decisions.

When Should You Give Out Tiger Tickets?

Distribute Tiger Tickets whenever you see students demonstrating Respectful, Responsible, and Safe behaviors. Examples include:

- **Respectful:** Holding the door for others, using kind words, or listening attentively.
- **Responsible:** Turning in assignments on time, cleaning up after themselves, or following directions.
- **Safe:** Keeping hands to themselves, walking in the hallways, or reporting unsafe situations to an adult.

How to Hand Out Tiger Tickets:

- **Observe Positive Behavior:** Look for actions that align with our school-wide expectations.
- **Provide Behavior-Specific Praise:** Let the student know what they did well. For example: "Thank you for walking safely in the hallway" or "I appreciate how you helped your classmate clean up."
- **Give the Tiger Ticket:** Hand the ticket to the student while expressing your praise.

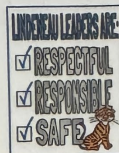
