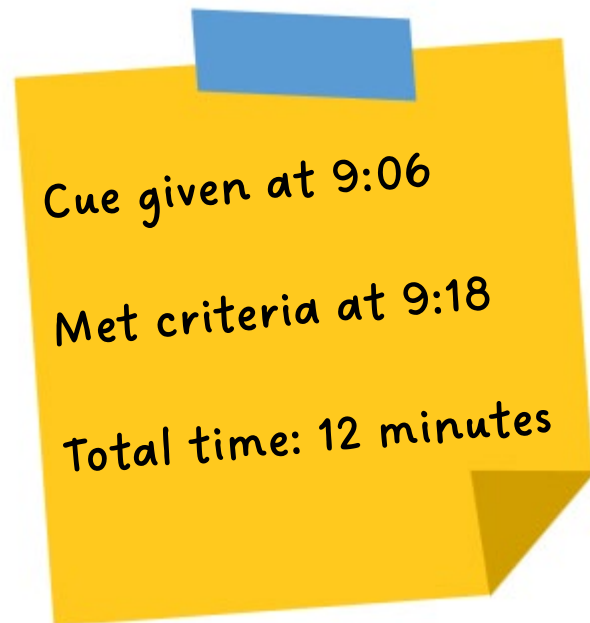


Using Latency Recording



Primary Data Question:

- How long does it take to initiate a specific behavior?

When to Use:

- ✓ To measure how long it takes for a student to start or stop a specific behavior (contextually appropriate or inappropriate behavior)

Examples:

- ✓ Reduce the number of minutes it takes to begin a task or follow a direction
- ✓ Increase the number of minutes waiting for a preferred activity

Implementation Resource

- ✓ Requires precision recording
- ✓ Pocket timer
- ✓ Requires an operationalized definition of the behavior being recorded
- ✓ Training on how to document
- ✓ Intermittent reliability calibration (2nd observer check for accurate recording)
